BUFFALO BILL

I was born to ride, born to survive: I do whatever it takes to get by.

Yeah, I love to live, I'm not afraid to die. 'Cause I was born. born, born to ride." This is a quote from William Frederick Cody. better known as "Buffalo Bill".

Bill Cody was born in 1846 in what is now Le Claire. Iowa and grew up on the prairie. The birthplace home of Cody, which was built in 1841 by his father Isaac Cody, is no longer in Le Claire. In 1933 it was purchased as a tourist attraction by the Chicago, Burlington and Quincy Railroad and was moved to Cody.

Wyoming, Cody's adopted hometown. A plaque marking the original site of the birthplace is in the 100 block on the west side of North Cody Road. But there is the 1847 farmhouse known as the Buffalo Bill Homestead, also built by Isaac Cody. It is of native limestone and contains walnut floors and trim. It is listed in the National Registry of Historic Places and is located on Bluff Street. Tours are available.


Le Claire also is host to a Buffalo Bill Museum. It houses Buffalo Bill memorabilia, the wood-hulled steamboat "Lone Star" (the last working one of

its kind on the Mississippi River; listed on the National Historic Register), and riverboat pilot exhibits. It is located at 199 N. Front Street.

While a child, the Cody family moved to his father's homeland of Canada and then in 1854 to Leavenworth in Kansas Territory. At the death of his father in 1857, Bill became the "man of the family", taking a job of driving a team of oxen to town at 50 cents a day. His next job, at age 12, was with the Overland Freight Company of Russell, Majors and Waddell, running messages for their office. Finding this too dull, he switched over to being a







herdsman for the company's large herd of oxen, traveling 40 miles to Fort Kearney and thus beginning the first of many adventures. In the book *The Life of Buffalo Bill*, he claims at the age of 14 to have ridden for the Pony Express. He also fought in the American Civil War and served as a scout for the Army. He was awarded the Medal of Honor in 1872 for "gallantry in action."

In 1867 Cody's skills as a marksman (from horseback) lead to a contract to supply buffalo meat to feed the construction crews of the Kansas-Pacific Railroad. Being successful at finding herds and killing many thousands of buffalo in seventeen months, earned him the nickname of Buffalo Bill.

All the while Cody was earning a reputation for skill and bravery in real life, he was also becoming a national folk hero, thanks to the exploits of his alter ego, "Buffalo Bill," in the dime novels of Ned Buntline. Beginning in 1869, Buntline created a Buffalo Bill who ranked with Davy Crockett, Daniel Boone and Kit Carson in the popular imagination, and who was, like

them, a mixture of incredible fact and romantic fiction. So he was an Old West legend before mounting his famous Wild West Show, where he became famous for his ultimate showmanship.

Nebraska would be the premier of Buffalo Bill's Wild West show which would eventually travel across the United States and even appear in Europe. It was a circus-like show with horses, cattle, covered wagons, costumed Indians, campfires and marksmanship.

Bill considered North Platte, Nebraska, his hometown and lived here for many years. North Platte residents basked in Cody's reflected glory during his lengthy career as a showman. At the Fort Cody Trading Post/Nebraska's Largest Souvenir and Western Gift Store, a 30-foot tall sign resembling Buffalo Bill greets you. Inside there are many exhibits, memorabilia and in miniature, over 20,000 tiny hand-carved figures populate dioramas of Bill's show, which traveled across America and even to Europe in 1877. The scenes were created by Ernie and Virginia Palmquist over a 12 year period. It is located at Halligan Drive/1-80 exit 177.

Not too far away at 2921 Scouts Rest Ranch Rd., is Buffalo Bill Ranch State Historical Park where Buffalo Bill's home, called Scout's Rest Ranch is located. It is a huge house he lived in during his heyday as a showman, now maintained as a state historical park. The Second Empire style





house was the largest in North Platte during the 19th century. He lived there from 1886 to 1913. He raised cattle and pure bred stallions on his 4000 acres of land.

The barn, once used to house horses, now contains a collection of antique carriages that belonged to Bill as well as a variety of memorabilia from the days of his world-famous Wild West Show. Every summer, a reenactment of his Wild West Show takes place 200 yards from the ranch.

Although Bill had a home in North Platte, he loved Wyoming and in 1895 founded the town of Cody. It became incorporated in 1901. Construction of Buffalo Bill Dam, named after the Wild West figure, and located six miles west of Cody was the key that opened about 90,000 acres in northwestern Wyoming to irrigated farming. When completed in 1910, Buffalo Bill Dam stood as an engineering

marvel, one of the first concrete arch dams built in the United States.


Another tribute to this Wild West figure is The Buffalo Bill Center of the West, a complex of five museums and a research library featuring art and artifacts of the American West. The five museums include the Buffalo Bill Museum, the **Plains** Indians Museum. the Whitney Western Art Museum, the Draper Natural

History Museum, and the Cody Firearms Museum. And in the Cashman Greever Garden, the original boyhood home now sits. The center is located at 720 Sheridan Ave in Cody.

And in Golden, Colorado, vou can visit the one and only grave of William F. "Buffalo Bill" Cody, located in Lookout Mountain Park, part of the Denver Mountain Parks system. The site overlooks the Great Plains and the Rockies and attracts over 400,000 annual visitors. The museum illustrates the life, times and legend of Cody. It includes many exhibits about his life and the Wild West shows. Native American objects, firearms and many other objects of the Old West. The museum was begun in 1921 by Johnny Baker, Buffalo Bill's foster son. It is located at 987 1/2 Lookout Mountain Road.

Herdsman, hunter, Old West legend, showman and conservationist....all names that fit the man known as Buffalo Bill.

Southern Tomato Pie

Layers of cheese, juicy ripe tomatoes, and fresh garden herbs come together in a flaky crust to create a savory pie everyone will love! This tomato pie dish can be served warm or cold for the perfect meal.

If you've never tried tomato pie, you absolutely have to! It's a southern dish that is one of my favorites-especially when it's made with fresh garden tomatoes. Roma tomatoes seems to work best, but you can use any tomatoes you have on hand.

Ingredients:

5 roma tomatoes, peeled and sliced 10 fresh basil leaves, chopped 1/2 cup chopped green onion 1 9-inch pre-baked deep-dish pie crust

½ cup cooked crumbled bacon
1 cup shredded mozzarella cheese
1 cup freshly shredded cheddar
cheese
3/4 cup mayonnaise
2 Tablespoons freshly grated
Parmesan cheese
Salt and freshly ground black pepper



Directions:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F.

Slice the tomatoes into thin slices and lay in a single layer in a colander.

Sprinkle with salt (this helps bring out their liquid), let them rest for 10 minutes.

Use a paper towel to pat-dry the tomatoes and make sure most of the excess juice is out. (You don't want wet (juicy) tomatoes or your pie will turn out soggy).

Layer the tomato slices, basil, and onion in pre-baked pie shell, then sprinkle crumbled bacon on top. Season with salt and pepper.

Combine the grated cheeses and mayonnaise together.

Spread mixture on top of the tomatoes and sprinkle Parmesan cheese on top.

Bake for 30 minutes or until lightly browned. Allow to rest for at least 15 minutes before cutting and serving.



Day Tripping

Tome times you are in an area where time is limited so you try to see what all is there in one day. I call that day tripping. Not too long ago we had one of those days in Bisbee, AZ. What fun!

Surrounded by the beautiful Mule Mountains, the town of Bisbee was founded as a silver and copper mining town in 1880, and named in honor of Judge DeWitt Bisbee, one of the financial backers of the adjacent Copper Queen Mine.

Bisbee ore was mined over a five mile-square area to a depth of 3,300 feet. And Bisbee's ore deposits held a few surprises...

glittering mineral specimens. As miners tunneled through the earth, they sometimes broke into caves whose walls sparkled with mineral crystals: bright blue azurite, deep green malachite, ruby-red cuprite and more. Although the rich copper ore made the town famous with the mining men, it was the striking beauty of the mineral specimens, displayed in museums and world fairs. that carried the name of Bisbee around the world.

For close to 100 years, the hills surrounding Bisbee produced copper and impressive amounts of gold, silver, lead and zinc. Eight

billion pounds of copper were mined. Finally, the deposits were exhausted. Operations were no longer economic. The mines shut down. In the 1950s. Phelps Dodge developed open-pit mining at the Copper Queen: this enabled mining operations to continue until 1975. Taking the Copper Queen Mine tour, which is offered daily, is to step back through the pages of history as you travel 1,500 feet into the mine and recount mining days, techniques, dangers and drama.

A stop at the Lavender Pit, which is an inactive open pit mine site covering 300 acres just east of Bisbee and near the Copper Queen Mine, vou will get an over-all view of what open pit mining is all about. The interpretive signs found here will explain the history and workings of the mine.

In town, we headed for the Old Bisbee Roasters. They are known for their freshly roasted specialty coffee. Inside the small operation we watched the roasting and grinding of coffee beans from countries Guatemala. Columbia. Brazil, India and many more. The smells were wonderful and we even sampled the Espresso.







Bags of freshly ground coffee were offered for sale along with the offer of buying online through their Roasters Choice subscription service.

Nestled in among the many unique shops found on Main Street, was the Killer Bee Guy or better known as the Honev Shop. The shop is located in a long narrow building where if you stretched out your arms you could touch either side of the wall. (I think it could be classified as claustrophobically small.) We learned that Reed Booth, owner and exterminator travels the region removing troublesome hives and collecting delicious sweet honey along the way. His shop specializes in making honev with Africanized bees that other honey purveyors would reject. Therefore lining the walls were shelves of every kind of honey you could imagine plus mustards and other goodies. Just peeking in the front window of the Optimo Custom Hatworks, I knew we had to venture inside. A "behind the

counter" tour of this museumlike shop was given by owner, artist/designer, milliner and renovator S. Grant Sergot. All the tools and equipment are originals from the 1800's and the styles are still done by hand in the old-world fashion.

When lunch time arrived, we headed to the small café that the locals recommended, Café Cornucopia. The favorite sandwich being meatloaf. So, of

course, we had to try it. There was no way our lips would go around that 5-inch plus meatloaf sandwich but where there is a will, there is a way!

We decided a stroll up the hill was in order after lunch and noticed many steps leading upward and signs stating 1,000 steps, etc. We found out that in 2019 Bisbee will celebrate the 29th annual Great Stair Climb, the only outdoor stair climb in



the U. S. It features 9 staircases connected by winding roads with a total course elevation gain/loss of 1175 ft. and covers 4.5 miles. It is one of the most challenging events in the world. (Unfortunately not an event we two could partake in....)

A "must see" is the Phelps Dodge General Office Building, a National Historic Landmark, and now the Bisbee Mining & Historical Museum. We were over-whelmed with all the exhibits which helps one to relive the dynamic and colorful mining past.

Located behind the museum is the Copper Queen Hotel which is also a National Historic Landmark.

It was built in 1898 and completed in 1902 and has four stories with Italian architectural style. A peek inside gave you an idea of how it was back in the mining days.

As we headed out of town, our last stop was at 1 Douglas RD. We couldn't help but notice the eye-catching 1950s mural on the side of the office building of the little trailer park, Shady Dell. Being RVers and of course curious, we drove in and talked to one of the owners. The park is actually for overnighters who want to spend the night or longer in a vintage trailer. He took us on a tour of the park,

where we could venture inside some of them. They have been refurbished inside and out and date from the 1930's. 40's and 50's with names like Airstream. Silver Streak, Crown and Kit. There was even a 1947 Airporter bus and a 1947 Chris Craft Yacht. It was definitely a step back in time and a great way to end our day-tripping adventure.



The RV market hasn't seen a full-blown electric motorhome just yet, but electric vehicles can still have a positive impact on RV camping by lending their powerful battery technology. With the new Nissan x OPUS camper trailer partnership, we see how EV batteries can fully power the equipment of a non-engined camper. The recycled Leafderived energy ROAM battery pack gives the innovative, award-winning Air OPUS inflatable four-sleeper enough juice to keep campers comfortable and fed for up to a week, all without the emissions and noise of a gas generator.





Each ROAM pack re-purposes lithium-ion battery cells pulled from first-generation Leaf vehicles, putting the recycled batteries to work for new purposes. Nissan's battery pack is removable and can be charged off the trailer, including in situations where you want to leave the trailer set up at camp and just carry the battery to a charging location. It only takes about an hour to charge from a 230V outlet or an estimated two to four hours from the 400W solar panel. The solar panel is an amazing

option for those who want to enjoy nature while also doing their part to preserve it. The battery pack turns the OPUS inflatable pop-up trailer into an off-roading adventure machine ready to serve up everyday electrical conveniences on travels that run farther and longer than average. The ROAM pack slides into a designated front-mounted compartment, providing 700-Wh of capacity. Manufacturers state that the battery will survive off-shore for at least seven days, when factoring in some help from the

12V leisure battery and included 400W solar panel. The system will power the on-board air compressor, which is used to inflate the "air poles" that support the OPUS' tent structure. The industry-leading AIR tent can be erected in approximately 90 seconds, allowing for a quick and easy set-up every time. The four-sleeper model comes equipped with two double beds (with a king bed conversion option), and a leatherette lounge



that converts into an additional double bed, bringing you to a total sleeping capacity of six. When inflated, the OPUS boasts massive 8-foot ceilings and large skylights that make the camper feel airy and spacious.



The AIR tent technology is the latest design innovation for OPUS, offered as an optional upgrade from the standard manual aluminum poles and designed to last through extremely high winds and even the roughest weather conditions. With the inflatable full-awning attachment, you can double the living space in the camper, and add an additional two double beds, allowing you to sleep up to ten campers

comfortably. That's enough room for even the largest crew! Other standard features include the kitchen necessities such as the portable microwave, two-burner gas stove and an electric fridge. Along with the on-road model that you see here, the OPUS Camper family also includes an offroading model, which is tailored toward the overlanding crowd. The off-road model features a full slide-out kitchen, equipped with a four burner stove, large dometic fridge, and enough kitchen storage for all of your cooking gear.



Given that this model is meant for overlanding, it comes standard with an all terrain-chassis, 15" off-road



tires, and independent coil suspension, perfectly suited to follow you wherever you go. Other upgradeable options for the OPUS lineup include a portable cassette toilet, hot-water shower, and stateof-the-art projector system to enjoy movie nights while off the grid. If you are planning on camping in the winter time during snow conditions, we recommend installing the 16,000 BTU propane heater. On the other hand, if you are planning on camping in the summertime under the hot sun, you

might want to consider the AC & heater option (this requires a plug-in power source, which explains their partnership with Nissan).
