Lookin' At Lubbock

They stand on 28-acres of rolling hills, an area known as Mackenzie Park...seventy historic restored windmills. Since Lubbock is the 3rd windiest city in the country, I think I will call them "sentinels in the wind". They are part of the American Wind Power Center and Museum, the world's largest wind powered museum. Many, many more are on exhibit inside the 33,000 square foot building plus a 6,600 square foot model train layout which celebrates the relationship between the railroad and windmills in the 1800's.

active and one of the premier archaeological natural and history sites in North America. It covers 336acres and is a protected state and federal landmark that contains evidence of almost 12,000 years of occupation by the ancient people. lt was also а prehistoric watering hole of the nowextinct giant Bison Antiqus and Mastadons and the amazing short-faced Bear.

The Landmark is committed to providing visitors of all ages with enriching experiences. There are maps for the walking trails that lead you to different historic sites. Wheelchair accessibility outdoors varies. There is RV parking available and admission is free. Information: 806-742-1116

Over 80 years ago a Spanish Renaissance Revival style train depot, considered one of the most largest and elaborate ones along the Lubbock-Estelline branch of the Burlington Railroad's Fort Worth and Denver City Line, greeted passengers as they disembarked from the train. Today it is on the National Register of Historic Places and houses The Buddy Holly Center and Museum.

The center collects, preserves and interprets artifacts relevant to the city's most famous son, Buddy Holly, as well as other West Texas performing artists and musicians. It showcases Buddy Holly memorabilia, changing exhibits, a gallery and gift shop.

This year marks the 61st anniversary of the traffic plane

crash that took the lives of Buddy Holly, Ritchie Valens, J.P. (The Big Bopper) Richardson and pilot Roger Peterson.



Jalapeño Popper Dip

This Jalapeño Popper Dip appetizer is a warm, creamy recipe with a crunchy topping that will be the surprise hit at any party or gathering. This easy Jalapeño Popper Dip is one of our favorites. It's the perfect dip to make during the winter months because it's a warm and creamy dip. Every time I make this dip, I always come home with an empty dish. It is that good! Oh, and don't worry, this dip is not blazing hot. It just has a slight kick. If you want it hotter, you could certainly add in more jalapeños.

Ingredients:

2 (8 ounce) packages cream cheese, softened
1 cup Mayonnaise
½ cup Cheddar Cheese Blend, shredded
½ cup Parmesan Cheese
1 4 oz can green chilies, diced
1 4 oz can jalapeños, diced (you can use fresh jalapenos
5 slices Bacon (Cooked and chopped)

Topping Ingredients:

½ cup crushed Ritz Crackers
 ½ cup Parmesan Cheese
 ½ stick melted butter

Directions:

Preheat oven to 375° degrees. Spray a 2-quart casserole dish with nonstick cooking spray.

Cook and stir bacon in a skillet over medium-heat until crisp, about 10 minutes. Remove bacon and put on a paper towel to drain. After cool, chop into small pieces.

Stir bacon, cream cheese, mayonnaise, Cheddar cheese, Mozzarella cheese and



jalapeno peppers together in a bowl, spread into a 9'inch round baking dish.

Mix crackers, Parmesan cheese, and butter together in a bowl, spread over the top of the cream cheese mixture.

Bake in preheated oven until bubbly, 20-30 minutes. Serve warm with Ritz crackers.




