Crockett Family Resort is an RV Park & Campground that sits on 16 acres of waterfront on trophy bass Houston County Lake in Crockett, Texas. Crockett is a tiny town where everybody knows each other, and it owes its name to Davy Crockett, who spent time here. The park has 116 RV Sites, 15 adjoining kitchenette cabins, 9 cabins scattered around the park, 5 high-end Park Models (tiny homes), 2 Cottages (family oriented tiny homes), and 2 dorms with 11 beds in each, 2 in-closed showers and toilets, a full kitchen in Dorm 126, and a door that conjoins the two.

The park has two clubhouses that host approximately 130 people. Each one has a separate full kitchen, with shared men's and ladies restrooms, closed off in between the two. Club House 2 features a fireplace. The front office has a store; Hunts Brothers Pizza, and a restaurant coming soon!!! It also has a 23 slip marina, a boat ramp, a heated pool, and a children's playground with putt-putt, shuffleboard, basketball and volleyball courts.

Amenities include: WiFi, restrooms, showers, laundry, phone, picnic tables, BBQ, fire rings, RV storage, heated swimming pool, store, ice, clubhouse, boat ramp, boating, fishing, ATV, basketball, playground, volleyball. Bike, golf card, canoe and paddle boat rentals available.

Area Attractions: Davy Crockett Festival Classic Car show in April, Texas State Railroad, Hot Pepper Festival in October, Texas Dogwood Trails Celebration in March and April, Annual Peanut Festival in October, and Christmas on the Square.

# A Story Through Pictures

**T**he Spirit of '44 nose art, so called because of the location on the fuselage of the aircraft, was morale-boosting, a good luck charm and a reminder of the pilots life. It created a powerful bond between the pilot and the machine.

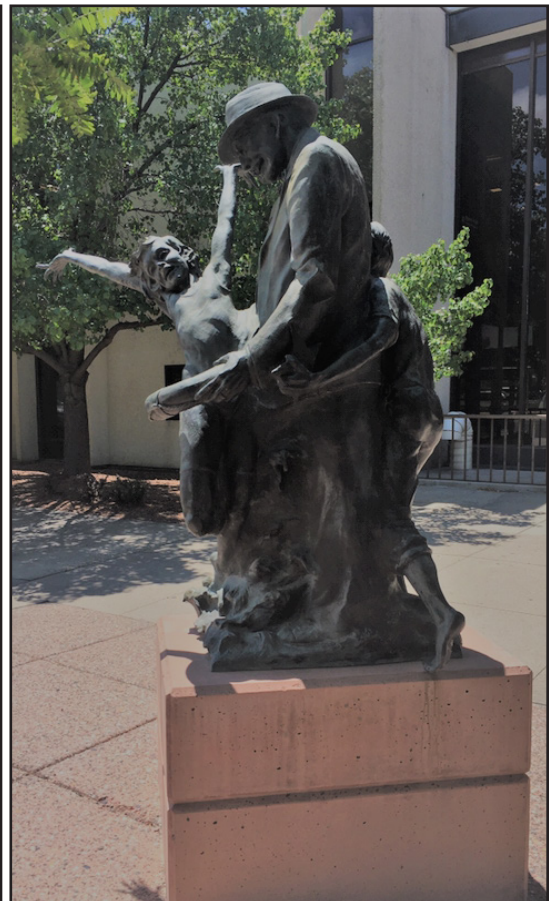
We found this nose art on a B-17 Flying Fortress heavy bomber, a low-wing monoplane which carried a crew of 10 and was developed in the 1930s for the United States Army Air Corp. It

is located at the Wings Over the Rockies Air and Space Museum in Englewood, Colorado.

We came upon this unique nest as we followed the trails of the Riparian Preserve at Water Ranch in Gilbert, Arizona. What little bird had built it? There are many found here...some just passing through, resting and feeding before they continue on their journey, while others are here to stay.

The preserve, established in 1999, is recognized as a premiere education and recreation resource for the visitor. And it provides not only a refuge for the birds but also for the wildlife, water fowl and even dragonflies that are found here.

Just recently, standing outside of the area where a former YMCA building once stood, we gazed upon the statue of William J. Moyer, one of Grand







join him. One has a rubber swimming tube around his waist. There were many tragic river drownings during this time in the Grand

Valley, including the son of one of their employees. Moyer vowed to build a public swimming pool so children would have a safe place to swim. In June of 1922 the Moyer Natatorium was opened. It was dubbed the largest concrete swimming pool in America. One provision of the gift was to provide one free day a week to children and it continues to this day.

Junction's business leaders and philanthropist. Ida and William J. Moyer were pioneers who founded the Fair Store, one of the largest retail businesses in Western Colorado. They had no children and used their wealth to help students, build roads, fund the YMCA and the construction of the Avalon Theater and the original Lincoln Park swimming pool.

If you look closely at the statue you will see that two small boys

Legend Dennis Weaver, who was a local resident to the near-by small mountain town of Ridgway, Colorado.

Weaver was an actor, director, producer and writer. He had minor roles in 22 movies but was mainly known for his role as Chester, the trusty deputy to Matt Dillon on the TV show Gunsmoke. He later became a TV star in his own right by portraying Marshal Sam McCloud.

In this region, homeland to the Lakota Sioux Indians and lying in the shadows of the Black Hills, is one of the 3 national cemeteries found in South Dakota....the Black Hills National Cemetery. Established in 1948, it is a United States National Cemetery near Sturgis and encompasses 105.9 acres and has over 30,000 interments.

As we look out over the grounds, we are reminded of all the national cemeteries with all of the headstones....looking the same. Who were these men and women who gave their lives so that we might have our freedom? Lest we forget? I think not.

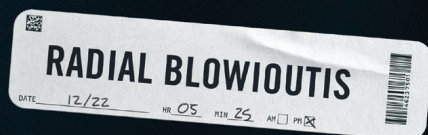

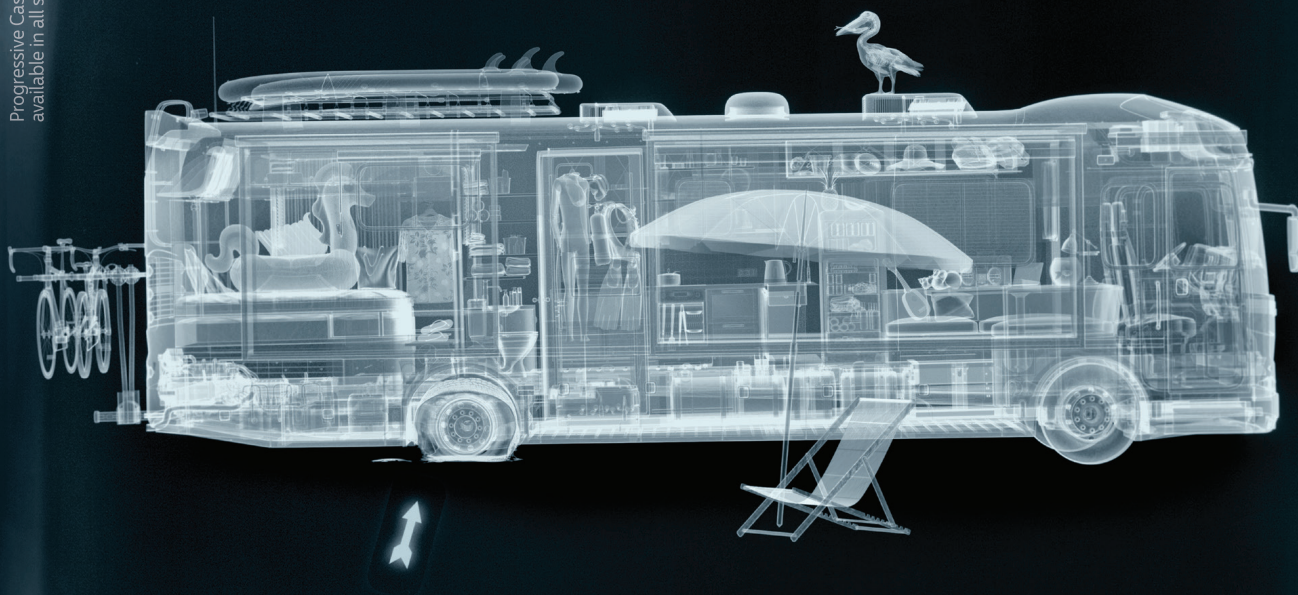

# Dark Chocolate Skillet S'Mores Dip

Making this easy dessert recipe (or snack) is quick and easy. To start, just add a layer of your favorite dark chocolate (or regular chocolate) to a 10-inch skillet then top it off with jumbo marshmallows. ## Then & Now / The Old & The New

**I**n my old Webster's Elementary School Dictionary, which contains 45,000 words and phrases, 900 illustrations and 720 pages, I found the meaning of old...."of the past, ancient, former and antiquated....long in use or has gone out of fashion." Also designating that one of two or more of the same kind which precedes the other.

In our travels, I love coming upon an old windmill out in a field or along side a barn. It seems that windmills have been around for centuries and they were used and continue to be used for pumping water or grinding grain. The windmill generates mechanical

energy by harnessing the wind. It was an amazing invention.

Today the windmill's modern equivalent, the wind turbine, can use the wind's energy to generate electricity. Wind turbines, like the windmill, are mounted on a tower to capture the most energy. It stands like a sentinel, slowly moving its arms. They are newer and more modern, but a sign of the times.







Using a horse, mule or oxen, the plow made its jerky slog through the dirt but was an upgrade from the hands and the hoe. In 1868 came the first engine-powered farm tractors which used steam. In 1892, Iowan John Froelich invented the first successful single-cylinder gas-powered tractor. It could reach 3 mph and took 26 gallons of gasoline to thresh 1,000 bushels of grain. Now rusted and forgotten it has been replaced by the tractor of today... comfortable swivel seats, implement controls at your fingertips, inner mirror for hitch view, beverage holder, sun visor, radio and well, I think you get the picture.

Robert E. Dietz patented his kerosene lamp in 1840. It burned an unfamiliar oil and was first used to light train tracks that criss-crossed the United States. It also brought light to homes, schools and businesses. But before the lamp, candles, whale oil and a dangerous mixture of turpentine and alcohol was the primary use for lighting.

In the mid-1800s everyone's life was changed with the invention of the electric light bulb. Prior to 1879, electricity had been used

in arc lights (gas discharge lamps which produce light by an arc between metal electrodes in a glass bulb). The light bulb invention used electricity to bring indoor lighting to homes.

Today we have incandescent, fluorescent, halogen and LED bulbs-including smart light bulbs. There are ceiling, chandeliers, track and recessed to name a few more. All, as a great option to choose from.

In 1876 Alexander Graham Bell made the first successful phone call and has been credited with the invention of the telephone since his design was the first patented. Since then telephones have come a long way. How did we come so far from that Wooden wall mount crank telephone



to the Bakelite rotary to today's mobile cell phone...from that can on a string to having the whole world in the palm of our hands?

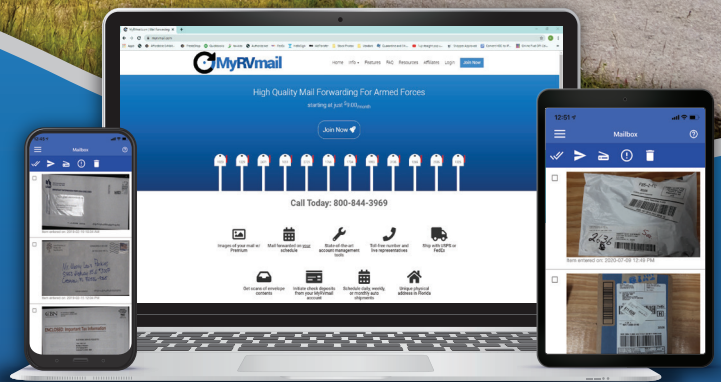
