



RV AMERICA MY STORY

Sego Canyon

he ruins of Sego lie amid beds of coal and clumps of sagebrush. The old, stone general store keeps watch over the ghost town...

As we mounted our ATVs for the days adventure, that ghost town was our destination. A friend had spent part of his growing up years in this area and offered to give us the tour and share its history with us.

Coal mining in Grand County,

Utah dates back to the first decade of the 20th Century when affluent farmer/rancher Harry Ballard found a thick outcropping of coal while out wandering through the maze of canyons adjacent his ranch. Keeping it a secret, he bought up the adjacent land and started a small coal mine.

For several years local people were hired to manually mine the coal and the small coal camp

became known as Ballard. As the mine became more active, the Denver and Rio Grande Railroad built a subsidiary railroad, the Ballard and Thompson, from the town of Thompson to the mine. The spur crossed streams 13 times in the 5-mile stretch. The coal was a good steaming quality, so the railroad bought as much of it for its own use as well as transporting elsewhere.

In 1910 Ballard sold his



property; the new owners formed the American Fuel Company with Richard Neslin as general manager. The town was called Neslin. The company built a store, boarding house, and several homes. Employees were allowed to build their own dwellings. At one time there were 500 people living here. Bachelors lived in the boarding house, families lived in anything and everything, from well-built homes to shacks, shanties and even dugouts in the hillsides.

In 1916 all was not well. Creeks and springs were drying up, there were many accidents and stockholders were upset. The company reorganized, handed Neslin his blue slip and changed the name of the town to Sego, after Utah's state flower the Sego lily which grew profusely in the canyon. The mine's name was also changed to Chesterfield Company.

In 1927, due to financial strain, the company was unable to make payroll so miners were paid in script (a substitute for legal tender) which could be spent at the camp store. In 1933 the miners reorganized under the United Mine Workers Union and



were finally paid regularly. In 1947, production costs were out-stripping income, and the company was ordered to close down and offered for sale. The unhappy 27 remaining employees banded together and bought the mine. It became known as the Utah Grand Coal Company. Although successful the first year, two separate fires later destroyed the tipple and equipment. In 1955 when the railroad converted to diesel locomotives, eliminating the need for coal, the Utah Grand Coal Company sold its holdings. And Sego was no more.

In October of 2017, much

of the historic area of Sego was listed on the National Register of Historic Places as the Ballard-Sego Coal Mine Historic District.









Foil-Packet Shrimp & Sausage Jambalaya

This hearty, satisfying dinner has all the flavors of an authentic jambalaya with little effort. The foil packets can be prepared a day ahead and cooked right before serving. These are also good on the grill! Makes 6 servings.

INGREDIENTS:

- 12 ounces uncooked shrimp (34-40 per pound), peeled & deveined
- 12 ounces fully cooked sausage links, cut into ½-inch slices
- 1 medium green pepper, chopped
- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 2 celery ribs, chopped
- 3 garlic cloves, minced
- 1 can (14 ½ ounces) fire-roasted diced tomatoes, drained
- 12 cup chicken broth
- 1 cup uncooked instant rice
- 1 can (8 ounces) tomato sauce
- 1 teaspoons Creole seasoning



DIRECTIONS:

Preheat oven to 425°. In a large bowl, combine all ingredients. Divide mixture among 6 greased 18x12-in. pieces of heavy-duty foil. Fold foil around mixture and crimp edges to seal, forming packets; place on a baking sheet. Bake until shrimp turn pink and rice is tender, 20-25 minutes.


KITCHEN TIPS:

- Make sure to use instant rice. If you use long grain or converted rice, the shrimp will be done long before the rice.
- Wear oven mitts when opening the packets to protect hands from escaping steam.



RV AMERICA MY STORY

A Tall Tale

e's a gun slingingtornado riding cowboy known as Pecos Bill. A fictional legend that first appeared in 1917.

Legend has it that in the 1830s Pecos Bill was the youngest of eighteen children to Texas pioneers. He was a tough little baby...using a bowie knife for a teething ring! He falls out of a covered wagon and is raised by a family of coyotes. These coyotes raise him as their own and teach him how to survive in the wild.

Growing out of the imaginations of Southwestern cowboys during the American Westward expansion, Pecos Bill personifies the frontier virtues of courage, strength, and humor. Each story was added to and embellished as they sat around the campfire at the end of a long day from heading cattle.

Edward S. O'Reilly published these writings in the form of short stories in 1923 and is an early example of "folklore". And Steven Kellogg, a writer and illustrator has created more than 100 children's books and is known for his classic American characters like Pecos Bill, Paul Bunyan, and Johnny Appleseed.

Disney introduced Pecos Bill, a cartoon character, in 1948 in an animated short from the film Melody Time which was a musical anthology featuring seven short musicals that sing, swing and tells tall tales. Roy Rogers, a favorite among children during that time, was chosen to sing and talk about the Texas cowboy named Pecos Bill, his horse Widow-Maker, and his romance with Slue Foot Sue.

In 1995, Disney again

introduced Pecos Bill to movie goers with Patrick Swayze starring as the larger-than-life hero taking us on unbelievable adventures.

So, is Pecos Bill a folklore or a tall tale? And does it really make a difference? I'm thinking that maybe Pecos Bill was created to teach us not to be afraid of difficulties, but to have courage, to be friendly and not to be envious... and maybe to have a little bit of fun along the way!

The West of Pecos Museum features a small area, dedicated to Pecos Bill along with many other exhibits. Across the street at the Pecos Chamber of Commerce / Visitor Bureau is the larger-thanlife Pecos Bill Boot, and the sculpture of Pecos Bill riding a tornado.




